APPRENTICESHIP OF THE WEEK

THERAPY SUPPORT WORKER

Therapy Support Workers are healthcare professionals who assist therapists, clinicians, and other healthcare professionals in providing therapeutic services to patients. They play a vital role in the rehabilitation and treatment process, helping individuals regain or improve their physical, mental, or emotional well-being. They provide direct care to patients, including assisting with exercises, mobility, and activities of daily living. Qualities and skills essential in this profession include strong interpersonal skills, an empathetic nature, physical stamina while moving patients and their property as well as attention to detail for effective record keeping etc. With experience and further education, Therapy Support Workers may advance to roles with more responsibilities, such as becoming a licensed physical therapy assistant or occupational therapy assistant.

A career in **Arts Therapy** involves using art, drama or music to help patients with physical, mental or emotional difficulties express themselves and progress with their recovery and overall wellbeing. You must hold a bachelor's degree and then enrol in a postgraduate diploma or Master's that has received approval from the Health and Care Professions Council.
