
T LEVEL THURSDAY - WORK BASED SUPERVISOR EFFECTIVE MENTORING WORKSHOP

APPRENTICESHIP OF THE WEEK

BUSINESS ADMINISTRATOR



The <u>Level 3 Business Administrator</u> apprenticeship is designed to equip aspiring professionals with the skills and knowledge necessary to thrive in the field of administration. Whether you're a recent school leaver or someone looking to upskill and advance in your career, this apprenticeship provides a solid foundation for success. Knowledge, skills and behaviours that this apprenticeship entails include effective use of IT systems such as Microsoft Office, record and document production including understanding of confidentiality, understanding of efficient organisational skills and naturally effective communication skills written and verbal. Upon completing the Level 3 Business Administrator Apprenticeship you could explore roles in particular within a healthcare setting such as within payroll, data entry, IT, marketing/comms, education and development or finance, or for instance administration within a clinical setting (ward clerks etc.) You may also wish to take on a more advanced apprenticeship if such a program is offered including the <u>Level 4 Policy Officer</u> or a leadership and management scheme such as the <u>Level 5 Operations/Departmental Manager</u>.

CAREER OF THE WEEK

AUDIOLOGY

Our **Audiology** team focus on the study and investigation of hearing, balance, and related disorders. A career in such a sector will likely require a undergraduate degree in audiology or a related field such as biology or psychology. You could also enter through a degree apprenticeship such as the <u>Level 6 Healthcare Science Practitioner: Audiology</u>. A work experience placement may also be of use in a department. You will naturally need to have outstanding verbal and written communication skills, attention to detail, empathy and willingness to research and implement new methods and practices.
