

APPRENTICESHIP OF THE WEEK

MEDICAL LABORATORY ASSISTANT

- The **Medical Laboratory Assistant** (MLA) apprenticeship is a specialized training program designed to provide individuals with the knowledge and skills required to work as entry-level professionals in medical laboratories. This apprenticeship program combines classroom instruction with on-the-job training to ensure apprentices gain an understanding of laboratory procedures, equipment operation, and specimen handling.
- Apprentices receive hands-on training in medical laboratories, where they work alongside experienced laboratory personnel. Under the supervision of qualified professionals, apprentices learn how to perform various tasks, including specimen collection, preparation, and analysis. They gain practical experience in operating laboratory equipment, maintaining cleanliness and safety standards, and handling sensitive information.
- Upon successfully completing the apprenticeship program, apprentices may be eligible to obtain certification or qualification as a Medical Laboratory Assistant.





CAREER OF THE WEEK

MEDICAL PHOTOGRAPHY

- Starting a career in **Medical Photography** requires education, skills, and practical experience. While a formal degree in Medical Photography is not always required, it can enhance your knowledge and job prospects. Look for programs that offer courses in medical imaging, photography techniques and medical terminology. Consider pursuing a degree in photography, visual arts, or a related field, and ensure that the program includes coursework specific to medical or scientific imaging.
- Practical experience is crucial for a career in Medical Photography. Look for
 opportunities to gain hands-on experience. Contact hospitals or research
 institutions to inquire about work experience or shadowing opportunities in
 their medical photography departments. This exposure will provide valuable
 insights into the profession and allow you to build a portfolio of medical
 images.
- Medical photography is an evolving field, with new techniques and technologies constantly emerging. Stay updated with advancements in medical imaging, photography equipment, and software. Attend workshops, take additional courses, and engage in continuous learning to enhance your skills and remain competitive in the field.
- FACT: T Levels are a new type of qualification in England that were introduced in September 2020. They are designed to offer a technical alternative to A Levels, focusing on practical skills and industry knowledge.
