

APPRENTICESHIP OF THE WEEK

IT SOLUTIONS TECHNICIAN



IT Solutions Technicians are members of our Information Technology team who are responsible for developing, implementing and maintaining an organisation's IT solutions, including hardware, software (such as operating systems and application installations) and other infrastructure. They will work as part of a multi-disciplinary team responsible for a broad range of activities to manage IT solutions. Naturally, they will also be expected to provide any technical support required to users and liaise with other IT professionals such as network administrators to ensure that systems are integrated and work together effectively. Entry requirements for this standard are that candidates must have achieved at least five GCSEs at C or above including English and Maths, and moreover should have an aptitude for problem solving and an enthusiasm for technology. Within this role, apprentices could progress onwards to Advanced Apprenticeship/Level 4 standards such as the Network Engineer or Cybersecurity Technologist apprenticeships, or may take on more senior roles within their team such as IT team leader or IT manager.

CAREER OF THE WEEK SUSTAINABILITY

Careers in **Sustainability** will largely entail a focus on environmental and/or social justice issues. People may choose such a career in this field due to values or a burning passion they hold, a particular knowledge base they have in sustainability-related fields, the growing career opportunities in this sector or all of the above. A variety of roles exist in sustainability from generalist roles such as Sustainability Officer or Consultant to more focused roles dictated by the organisation's activities or mission. In our Trust, sustainability has been made a core value and goal with a Climate Emergency having been declared and a Green Plan being devised, declaring the goal of reaching carbon neutrality by 2040. An annual sustainability report is also publishing detailing the progress the Trust has made so far on these goals. Another initiative is The Big Green Conversation which aims to bring together crossparty working across the Trust in order to re-energise our focus on sustainability and climate change, develop a network of 'sustainability champions' to represent the issue and identify our priorities. Therefore, this is an exciting career which will be of paramount importance to the Trust both at present and in the future.
