

Thursday Trip Choices

Legoland Windsor - For an awesome day out visit LEGOLAND and experience the ultimate LEGO adventure! 100 spaces. 8:30am – 5:30pm. **COST: £29**

Cotswold Wildlife Park - Stroll around the Park and get eye-to-eye with Giraffe, watch Rhinos graze on the Manor House lawns, walk with Lemurs or explore the Skymaze full of interconnecting treehouses with jungle bridges and slides.

150 spaces. 9am – 4pm. COST: £17

West Midlands Safari Park - home to a variety of all-weather attractions, including four miles of drive-through safari, a thrilling dinosaur exhibit and a theme park. 48 spaces. 9am – 5pm COST: £32

Go Ape! - tackle dangling obstacles, explore the trees from a new perspective and fly around on multiple ziplines from exciting heights 26 spaces.9am – 3pm. **COST: £38**

Mountain Biking – (includes bike hire and professional guides) exploring some of the mountain bike trails in the beautiful Forest of Dean *students taking part must be able to confidently ride a bike 15 spaces. 9am – 4pm COST: £54 (includes bike hire)

Bristol Activity Centre - Low impact paintballing in "Call of Duty" and "Fortnight" inspired game maps including real tanks, helicopters, underground bunkers, and even a boat! Followed by axe throwing, remember it's all about technique not the strength. 40 spaces. 8:30am - 4pm **COST: £50**

Croft Farm (Not overnight residential) - Raft build challenge, kayaking & paddle boarding
*All students attending must be water confident and able to swim 10m.
40 spaces 9am - 5pm COST: £56



Thursday Trip Choices

The two choices below are in school activities which will take place during the regular timings of the school day.

Food making – Learn how to make a range of baked goods, spend some time with the canteen staff before going for a walk up Chosen Hill to picnic on your creations. **COST: £5**

Make & Do – Making a range of things including bath bombs. - Free of charge.





Trip Booking Information

The trips will be live on the School Gateway from midnight on Monday 3rd February until Sunday 23rd February 2025.

To secure your child's place, full payment is required via the School Gateway. For trips over £35, a £25 deposit is required with the remaining balance of trips will be due by 30th March 2025. At the point of deposit payment any trip changes will not be permitted.

The costs shown are based on meeting the minimum numbers for the trips to be viable. Places are available on a first come first served basis. Should we not reach the minimum numbers for a trip, the trip may be cancelled and in this instance a refund will be given.

If your child is eligible for Pupil Premium funding we would ask that you contact Ms Vanessa Shelton, Pupil Premium Manager, by emailing vsh@choseh-hill.gloucs.sch.uk so that she can discuss this with you prior to the 'go live' date.

Should your child not wish to attend one of the out of school trips, there will be activities on school site.

We hope that you value the opportunities and experience Enrichment Week provides all students. To ensure that the week can run as planned and all students are able to fully take part and engage in the entire week, we are asking for a voluntary contribution (suggested minimum of £5.00) from each student in Years 7, 8 & 9. This can be paid via the School Gateway at any time from now until Sunday 13th July 2024.



Enrichment Week FAQ

When is Enrichment Week?

Enrichment Week this year will be running from Monday 7th July to Friday 11th July 2025.

Which Year groups take part in Enrichment week?

Enrichment week is offered to all students in Years 7, 8 and 9.

What happens during Enrichment week?

There is a set timetable of fun and educational activities for the students. On Thursday 10th July, there is an opportunity for your child to take part in an off site trip as detailed in the Enrichment Week letter.

My child is already booked onto a residential trip during Enrichment Week, do I need to do anything?

No. If your child is booked onto the Year 8 or 9 Camps, Croft Farm or Paris trip, there is no need for you to choose any further activities running that week.

My child wants to go on the same trip as their friends.

We suggest that your child discusses their preferred option with their friends before you pay for their trip. If they do not manage to book onto the same trip as their friend then Enrichment Week provides a fantastic opportunity to meet new friends and build on other friendships.



Enrichment Week FAQ

When can I book the Thursday day trips?

Day trips will be live on the School Gateway from midnight on Monday 3rd February 2025. Full payment will be required (unless over £35) at the time of booking to secure your child's place. The deadline to make a trip selection is Sunday 23rd February 2025.

Why can I not see the trip my child would like to join?

Some trips are very popular and have a capped number of places due to the number of tickets or size of coach we have been able to secure. Once trips are full you will no longer be able to see/book them on School Gateway.

How much do the trips cost?

Each trip has an individual cost. These can be found on page 8 of this booklet and on School Gateway when booking. We ask for a separate voluntary contribution (suggested minimum amount £5.00 per student) to contribute to the on-site activities and ensure we can provide as many experiences and engaging activities as possible.

My child has changed their mind – can they swap to a different trip?

It is not possible to change activities once you have confirmed your choice by making payment.



Enrichment Week FAQ

My child does not want to go on any of the 'Out of school' trips offered?

Any student who does not wish to go on an 'Out of school' trip on the Thursday should still attend school to complete in school activities.

My child is on the waiting list for a residential trip, should I still book a day trip?

As we cannot guarantee those on the residential trip waiting lists a space, you should still book your child onto a day trip, should a space on the residential trip then become available, this will be discussed on an individual basis.

When will I know that my child has a space on a trip?

If you have paid in full and have a receipt of payment from the School Gateway, your child's space on the trip is secured.

My child is Pupil Premium, what support is available?

Please contact Mrs Shelton, Pupil Premium Manager vsh@chosenhill.gloucs.sch.uk prior to the 'Go Live' date to discuss additional support as spaces cannot be reserved.
